Target Species: Water chestnut (*Trapa natans*)

First year of treatment? No, DEC staff have performed annual management of the infestations through hand pulling for approximately 10 years. The first record of water chestnut in Fawn Lake was in 2011.

Size of infestation: <10 sq. ft.

Treatment Method (please be specific): Mechanical – Hand pull

% Completed: 100%

Amount removed: (# bags, # plants, # mature, # seedlings): 8 plants

Time spent on removal: 15 minutes

Is follow-up needed? Yes, annual management should continue between mid-June-July until seed bank is presumed eliminated.
