Five Rivers Environmental Education Center where mile-a-minute was introduced from crusher run gravel. There are 2 main sites where infestations have been found, one where they put the crusher run down for the trail by the river, and one where the gravel was staged up above by an old barn. There were 28 plants removed from the river earlier in the summer by the workers of the Five Rivers and 20 plants were removed from the staging area by Capital Region Prism.
