**Project Description and Summary of Work Completed:**

Pine Hollow Arboretum, a partner of the Capital Mohawk PRISM, agreed to treat and eradicate in-house with a certified applicator Japanese Angelica Tree (*Aralia elata*). The arboretum had a specimen of the invasive tree *Aralia elata* that had colonized to approximately a tenth of an acre. The *Aralia* had gone to flower this season but the park manager cut the flower heads off prior to a basal bark treatment. The *Aralia elata* was an intentional planting. Approximately 45 stems were treated. The specimens were no larger than 1.5 inches in diameter.
